What is a Trustee? A trustee is someone who is part of a team who are responsible for running a charity.

Team work = Dream work

<u>Trustees are responsible for</u>: -Managing staff and volunteers, money, making decisions about the operation of the charity.



Trustees can be known as Directors, Governors, Committee Members and Board Members. As a charity we are governed by a governing document, it is this legal document that states what the charity can do.

Who can be a trustee? - Anyone over the age of 18.

<u>Who chooses trustees?</u> -Choosing a trustee is usually called appointing a trustee, the people who are already trustees vote to appoint new trustees

What is expected of a Trustee?

- Attend a minimum of 3 committee meetings per annum
- Have good independent judgement and integrity.
- To think creatively and willingness to speak their mind.
- Show willingness to work collectively as part of a group
- Have a commitment to the organisation & its objectives.
- Have an understanding and acceptance of the legal duties, responsibilities and liabilities of trusteeship.
- Keep the organisations business confidential.
- Have a willingness to devote the necessary time & effort to their duties.
- Believe in the ethos of the charity.
- Be supportive
- Be motivated
